season, diverting to Newcastle in the early hours of Sunday 6th on a flight from Sharm-el-Sheikh owing to a reduced landing distance at Edinburgh due to work in progress. The aircraft, leased to Sunwing from Hapag-Lloyd wore the classic 'orange' colour-scheme of the German carrier.

**UK REGISTERED VISITORS**No notable British airliner ad-hoc visitors during October, and a poorer showing from the domestic biz jet contingent too, only one of the thirteen such aircraft to appear during the month being worthy of mention, Citation Bravo **G-OPEM** which made two landings on Friday 18th, the aeroplane having made only one previous appearance here during August 2013.

Mid-October saw the re-appearance at Newcastle Airport of one of the 'closest' locally-based fixed-wing aircraft, the Currock Hill-based Grob 109 **G-KNEK** diverting in due to bad weather on a flight from Carlisle on the afternoon of Saturday 12th, the aeroplane making the short trip home the following morning. Its first landing here for over ten years, it had first appeared here on 18th June 2000, with further landings occurring during a short 'detachment' from 27th June to 4th July 2001. The first day of the month produced the only notable British helicopters during October, both first-visitors, the Yorkshire Air Ambulance's 'TV star' MD.902 Explorer **G-CEMS** calling in for fuel from the Freeman Hospital during the afternoon of Tuesday 1st, while Jet Ranger **G-ILYA** followed for its first landing here later in the afternoon whilst on local pipeline patrols - coming full circle from the aircraft which started off this month's rundown, the rather vintage aircraft had originally been delivered new to the Royal Saudi Air Force in 1968!
